

FUNDRAISING CHECK LIST

Have a plan – and stick to it!

What? Think about how you want to raise money and what materials you will need to do this.

When? You will also need to think carefully about when you will fundraise. Make sure you give yourself plenty of time to organise your activity and try not to clash with other events.

Where? Think about where you will hold your event, will it be at your school, inside or outdoors? You may need to book a venue, and you will have to consider disabled access and how people will get there.

How much? Set yourself a target and a budget. If you keep your costs low, there will be more profits for you to pass on to the charity. Can you ask people to donate goods or services, could a company sponsor you?

Let people know what you are doing!

Shout about it on social media. Keep people updated on how you are getting on. Don't forget to use our hashtags

You can even contact your local paper to see if they would like to run a story on what you are doing.

Remember: The more people who know about your fundraising the more you will raise.


Say Thank You



Jack, aged 4, was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia. This is where the bone marrow makes white blood cells that don't work. These cells can't protect the body from germs. They crowd the bone marrow, enter the bloodstream, and can spread to other parts of the body.

Jack eats, sleeps and breathes dinosaurs. He had heard about a special attraction in London that had lots of dinosaurs.

So, his wish was to visit the Jurassic World Exhibition in London.





Daisy, aged 10, has cystic fibrosis. This is a disease that causes the body to make very thick, sticky mucus. This is a problem for Daisy's lungs and digestive system.

Daisy can find it tricky to breathe and can get infections very easily. She needs to take lots of medicine to keep her healthy. She has to get up early every morning to do special exercises.

Daisy loves Lego, fairytales and princesses.

Her wish was to visit Legoland with her family.
